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## Introduction


Conditions causing chronic, often intermittent pain affecting the joints or connective tissue. Rheumatism does not designate any specific disorder but covers at least 200 different conditions.

## Causes

Genetic and environmental factors may be some of the causes.

It occurs when your immune system attacks the synovium — the lining of the membranes that surrounds the joints.
