Herpes zoster (VZV)

is viral infection that occurs witl.

reactivation of the varicella-zoster virus. It is usually a painful but self-limited derma rash.


<u>Causes</u> : is caused by the same virus that causes varicella (chickenpox) Primary infection with VZV causes varicella. After a person has varicella, the virus remains latent in the dorsal root ganglia

Symptoms

Fluid-filled blisters that break open and crust over.

- A red rash
- Sensitivity to touch
- Pain , burning.
- Itching





- Wet cold compresses



Prevention

The CDC recommends two doses of recombinant zoster vaccine (RZV, Shingrix) to prevent shingles by 2 to 6 months.

•And protection from related complications in adults 50 years and older Shingrix is also recommended for adults 19 years and older and who have a weakened

immune system due to disease or treatment.
