
1- DEFINE "COMPUTER"

A piece of electronic equipment that is capable of running programs, interacting with a user (via input—output devices), and storing data.

- Processing –(ex- CPU)
- Output –(ex- Monitor)
- Storage –(ex- Memory)

Commonly known as the IPOS.



3- LIST VARIOUS TYPES OF COMPUTER SYSTEMS


- > Supercomputers

- handheld devices such as cell phones and mp3 players


4- WHAT ARE THE 2 MAIN COMPONENTS OF COMPUTER SYSTEM

Software: a list of instructions that detail to the computer what to do.


Hardware: the physical components of the computer

5- LIST EXAMPLES OF HARDWARE DEVICES WITH USES










CPU


The central processing unit, or processor, stored on a single chip, known as the microprocessor.

MEMORY


Most computer memory is stored in RAM. We usually refer to this as memory or main memory.

SYSTEM UNIT


This is a case into which you will place several key components of the computer. The most important component is the motherboard.
